Fixed Wing General Aircraft Handling Signals Arms down with palms towards ground, then moved up and down several times Same as day signal with addition of wands Conforms to ICAO signal Extend right arm horizontally, left arm is repeatedly moved upward Speed of arm movement indicating rate of turn Same as day signal with addition of wands 1
